Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

Malolactic fermentation in barrel with native yeast and bacteria.

Maturation: Matured on fine lees for 12 months.

Racked and lightly filtered before bottling.

Production: 4000 bottles per year

Bottled at the estate.



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
